
MEN'S CONNECTION GROUP



FALLING FOR DONUTS FALL EXPERIENCE BOX FOR ALL



NEW COVID-19 GUIDELINES

Starting **October 1, 2021**, NHF and national chapter face to face meetings and events (indoors and outdoors) will require that all attendees, including NHF staff and sponsors aged 12 and older, show proof of being fully vaccinated or a negative COVID-19 test within 72 hours of attending the event. Additionally, for indoor events, all attendees must wear masks regardless of vaccination status. NHF strongly recommends that all attendees wear masks at outdoor events as well, but hosts should follow the strictest guidelines – either CDC, local, regional or state guidelines.

- Teaches parenting attitudes, knowledge, beliefs, and behaviors
- Delivers tools to help with planning for the future
- Encourages parent personal awareness
- Improves family health, viability, engagement, and interaction
- Connects parents with other parents and reduces the feeling of isolation

This Empact program will include –

- Online videos and educational content; about 30 minutes each week
- Five scheduled 1-hour facilitated Zoom discussions
- Electronic Parent Workbook and Materials

Weekly parent-to-parent zoom sessions will start on October 20 at 6:30P Mountain Time.


